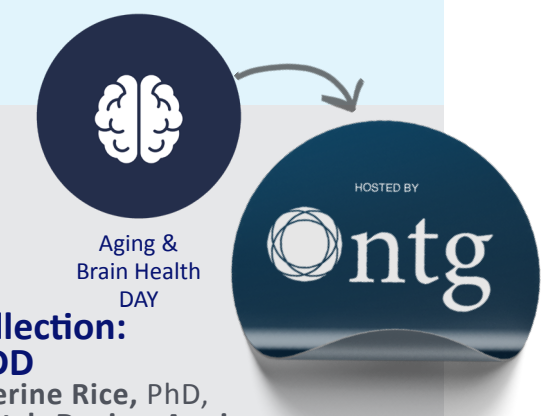

- Curriculum Innovation**
